LIKENESS is guest curated by InLiquid member, Brooke Hine. InLiquid provides the public with immediate access to view the portfolios of over 270 artists via the internet, through "real world" activities and exhibitions in a variety of venues, and through an extensive online body of timely art information--including gallery listings, articles, reviews, artist resources, links, and discussions. InLiquid brings to light the richness of our region's art activity and broadens audiences for all forms of visual culture.

This exhibition showcases paintings, bas-reliefs, and graphite drawings that examine the enduring challenge of and fascination with the depiction of the self, from the perspective of both artist and subject. For thousands of years, portraitists have served the steady demand of men and women who desired to have their likenesses preserved on canvas.
